Student Registration & Class Enrollment

With our season's registration opening on August 1, here's a guide to help you through the process.

- If you are new to Expressions Dance Academy, you will have to **register** your student first before they can **enroll** in classes. You can **register** by going here: <https://app.jackrabbitclass.com/regv2.asp?id=538405>
 - www.expressionsdancegr.com then click "Register", then click "Register Here"
 - When you register, there will be a place to enter your credit card information *if you wish to be auto billed each month*. If you select that you do not want to be autobilled on the drop down menu, you will not be required to enter in a credit card number.

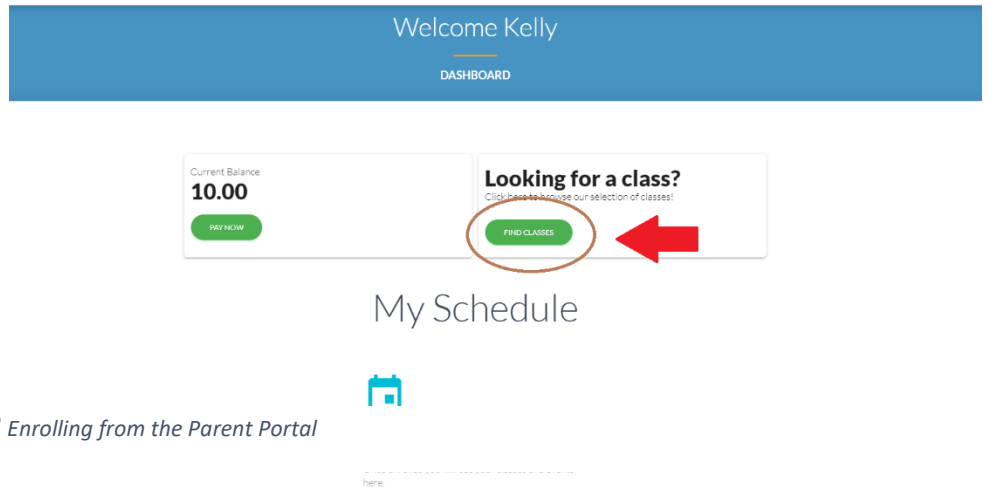
1 Registration Screen

- Here's some information to help you navigate our schedule/enrollment process:
 - Recreational classes are open to all dancers, new and returning. Classes are held once weekly (or in the case of the Adult classes, every other week). Classes are \$60 per month. Recreational dancers have the option to perform in the season-end Dance Recital in June with the purchase of a \$75 costume that they get to keep. The \$75 costume payment isn't due for a couple months after the start of the season, so you have some time to decide.
 - If your recreational dancer wants to do a solo (meaning they have a half hour time slot each week that is dedicated just to them and

the teacher, and they get to do a dance by themselves at Recital), you can enroll them for the "Solo *RECREATIONAL ONLY*". The time listed is NOT ACCURATE. After enrolling, please send an email to expressions_dnc@yahoo.com stating your dancers name, age, which style of dance they want to do, if

they have a teacher preference (although there is NO GUARANTEE they will get that teacher) and their availability. Please note that we have limited availability and space, so we may not be able to accommodate all soloist times.



- Competition Team Classes are for dancers that have auditioned for the competition team for the current year. Classes are held once weekly, and may have additional required technique, so please read the class description carefully. Dancers are required to attend and pay for all costumes, performances, and competitions that we attend that season. Competition Team Classes are denoted by “*Comp Team:” so that you know for sure it is a competition team class.
 - “*Comp Team Regionals/Reg” are the regionals competition team classes that attend 3 regionals for the season. Cost is \$85 per month to take any amount of regionals classes.
 - Make sure you read the descriptions in the class as most of the classes has additional technique time which is required, but NOT specifically in the class hours. This is because the technique time is shared between a couple regionals classes, and it will not allow you to select multiple classes with the same technique time because it shows your schedule is already “full” at that time.
- Competition Team Solos/Duos/Trios/Closed Classes are for all competition team members who which to do a solo/duo/trio/closed class and which to compete it. The time listed is NOT ACCURATE. After enrolling, please send an email to expressions_dnc@yahoo.com stating your dancers name, age, which style of dance they want to do, if they have a teacher preference (although there is NO GUARANTEE they will get that teacher) and their availability. Please note that we have limited availability and space, so we may not be able to accommodate all times.
 - Special notes about Competition Team Solos/Duo/Trios/Closed Classes:
 - If 18 years or younger, you MUST be enrolled in at least 1 Competition Team Regionals class to take a Competition solo/duo/trio/closed class.
 - If you are doing a “family duo” such as mother/daughter, brother/sister, sister/sister, please enroll it as just a regular duo and then email us to let us know. The pricing adjustment will be made internally, and WON’T show up right away.
 - As we get more and more soloists, we are running out of time/free studio space, as well as certain teacher availability. Please understand this when signing up that we may not be able to accommodate the best time that works for you, or the teacher that you want. We have a wonderful staff of teachers who have many different and amazing talents that will each give your dancer the best they can, and rest assured we will only assign teachers who are qualified to teach your dancer. Our current teaching staff is as follows: Miss Jennifer, Miss Kelly, Miss Jillian, Miss Erin, Miss Laura, Miss Anna, Miss Zoe, Miss Brenna.

- Please note that if you enroll for a duo/trio/closed class, this is something that we expect that you have spoken with the other dancers you want in the duo/trio/closed class. Do not enroll expecting us to find you a duo/trio/closed class. If this is something you are interested in but don't know who to dance with, you can email us to ask us advice or see if we have anyone we can recommend, but do not enroll ahead of time for it until there has been an agreement between parties.
- If you email with questions regarding registration/enrollment, please allow a day or two for us to respond as it is our summer break at the moment and we have limited hours.
- If you enroll for a solo/duo/trio/closed class, make sure to send the email stating your dancers name, age, which style of dance they want to do, if they have a teacher preference (although there is NO GUARANTEE they will get that teacher) and their availability. *We will begin working on the solo/duo/trio/closed class schedule sometime after August 8th, so we recommend you enroll and email us before then.* We ask for your patience and understanding.
- If there seems to be a billing issue, please email us and allow us a couple days to respond. Because we have different discounts set up those who take multiple classes, occasionally if enrollment is done out of order or there are multiple discounts that apply to your account there will be a billing issue on the first month. Please email us and we will work to get it resolved.
- Solos vs Privates: Solos are the same half hour per week times that are set aside for your dancer, with the expectation that they learn a dance that is either performed at the end of the season recital, or competed. Cost is \$100 per month. Privates are half hour time slots that are set aside for additional practice with a teacher. They are paid for PER TIME, not monthly, and can be as many or as few as schedules allow. With privates, no dance is learned, it is just extra time to work on technique, skills, or any of their routines they have learned in their other classes. Private times are only available after all regular classes, solos/duos/trios/closed classes have been scheduled. Cost is \$20 per half hour.
